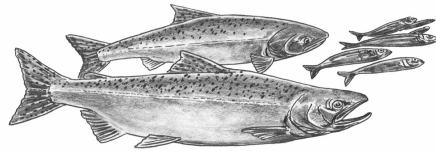


2013 Chimacum Beach Planting
