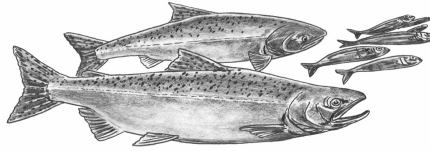


# 2010 Morse Creek Cabin Planting



## Project Summary

**Number of trees planted: 223**  
**Number of volunteers: 25**  
**Total Hours spent planting: 75**

Volunteers planted both the pergola pathway and the stormwater pond with a variety of native plants and shrubs. Volunteers also removed the invasive weed, Scotch Broom from the riparian area. Board member Mike Langley, with the help of volunteers completed deck improvements for the cabin.

## Morse Creek Cabin Planting February 6, 2010



With 25 volunteers and help from NOSC board members and staff, the future site of the Olympic Discovery Nature Center was landscaped with native trees and shrubs. The planting took place along the entrance pathway and storm water retention basin that was constructed by NOSC and volunteers in 2009. Members of Peninsula College's veterans club and the local community attended the planting. NOSC provided volunteers with education about salmon habitat restoration and salmon biology.
