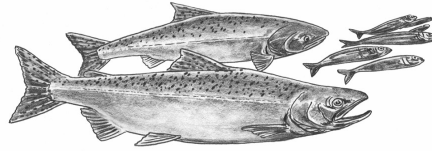


2010 Valley Creek Planting



Project Summary

Number of trees planted: 140

Number of volunteers: 4

Total volunteer hours: 12

Valley Creek's headwaters begin in the Olympic National Park and flows down into city of Port Angeles. This newly planted section of the creek was re-aligned and planted in 2005 as part of multi-phase project to restore the creek. In addition to learning about riparian vegetation, volunteers were also provided with a lesson about hydrologic soils.

Valley Creek Planting March 11, 2010

The North Olympic Peninsula Skills Center's Geologic Soils Class and NOSC staff helped to fill in a 2005 NOSC planting with native trees and shrubs that were donated by the Clallam County conservation district. This planting will provide this restored section of Valley Creek with the trees and shrubs that are needed to prevent excessive erosion and provided shade for the aquatic wildlife.
